## Where will we **Stay?**

We will stay in a modern hotel with the amenities that we are used to and with communications capabilities allowing us to connect with home if needed.

### **What's the weather like?**

At different times of the year there is a greater or lesser chance of rain, but you can count on one thing, it will be warm when we are there. Daily highs in Managua (the capital city) will be 80 to 100 degrees. The dry season generally runs from November through April and the rainy season is from May through October.

### **What do I need to bring?**

We will visit remote and somewhat rugged areas. This is not a place where nice clothes are required. Wear things that you don't mind getting dirty or worn. Jeans and long sleeve shirts are too warm for most people, we suggest khakis and short-sleeved shirts. Sturdy closed toe shoes are essential. Again, we will be on dirt paths and you should not mind a bit of wear.

You should bring sunscreen, insect repellent, and a hat. Hand sanitizer can be quite convenient. You will receive more information upon your registration to travel to Nicaragua.




## What will it **Cost?**

The base cost of these short trips is \$250 per person. This amount helps Rainbow Network offset staff and travel expenses. It also allows Rainbow Network to provide our groups with a translator and rental vehicle while in Nicaragua.

Additional Costs Include:

- Hotel Rooms (breakfast included)
- Airfare
- Meals



## When can I **Go?**

Witness the Miracle tours are scheduled on a regular basis. They are designed to give you an overview of Rainbow Network's life-changing ministry activities in Nicaragua in an action-packed two days.

Rainbow Network's staff in the USA can help you schedule a trip for your congregation or civic group or we can help single travelers or couples to find an already scheduled trip to join.



## What will we **Do?**

These short trips are designed to let you see Rainbow Network's ministry in action on the ground in rural Nicaragua. Together we will visit feeding centers, schools, medical clinics, dental clinics, micro-loan banks, housing projects, and more. There will be a lot of drive time, but even that can be exciting in rural Nicaragua.
